

SSG DGH Representative Job Description:

Term of office:

3 years

Eligibility:

Active & paid up member of the Scottish Society of Gastroenterology. Nominations will be submitted in writing to the Secretary and will consist of the signed agreement of the nominee, and the signatures of a proposer and seconder drawn from the Society. If a vote is required then this will be followed in line with the SSG constitution.

Job outline:

The District General Hospital (DGH) representative on the council should be a gastroenterologist working in a Scottish DGH. Their main role is to ensure appropriate representation for DGH Gastroenterologists and their teams, both through regular correspondence with the council via the secretariat at the RCPE, and by attendance (in person or virtually) at the quarterly meetings.

It's anticipated that within their role, the DGH representative will promote and encourage SSG membership amongst appropriate members of the multidisciplinary team, building an inclusive society rich in experience from a wide range of specialists. They will also be responsible for communicating pertinent information to the membership, as well as bringing appropriate issues to the attention of the council for discussion.
